After occupying the chair by the president, Mufti Khurshid Ahmed, the treasurer of the society addressed the members that, during the year ending on March 31, 2023, the organization has carried out several activities. The achievements of the society during the period under consideration were in the form of successful implementation and handling of the programs as below:

Following are the activities conducted during the financial year 2022-2023:

1. EDUCATION PROGRAMME:

Our organization is deeply committed to enhancing the educational landscape, exemplified by the Flah-E-Insaniyat Public School in Umra village, operated by our Zamiya Rawzatul-Uloom society. This institution caters to students from classes I to XII and holds a strategic location at a pivotal crossroads, ensuring accessibility for children across various parts of the community. The school, still undergoing expansion, boasts a sizable infrastructure with numerous components. Currently, it accommodates over 600 students within its walls.

The classrooms are spacious, thoughtfully furnished, and equipped with all essential amenities. Additionally, a well-appointed playground provides ample space for recreational activities. Our dedicated team comprises 10 proficient instructors, led by a seasoned supervisor who brings wisdom and experience to the educational journey. These educators are adept in their respective subjects, ensuring a high-quality learning environment.

In Umra village, we also operate a school exclusively for females, offering instruction in Hindi, English, Urdu, and Arabic at a nominal fee of 5000 rupees per year. Looking ahead, we have ambitious plans to launch a stay-and-learn program for both girls and boys, providing complimentary meals and school attendance, along with female educators exclusively focused on the contemporary education of girls. Additionally, our male-centric school offers complimentary

food and lodging, with an annual fee of just Rs 2000. Spanning 5 acres, Zamiya Rawzatul-Uloom stands as the singular institution tailored for male students, especially those who are orphaned. There is no parallel establishment in Nuh that provides both modern education and a secure residence. Ultimately, our overarching mission is to extend the gift of education to every child in our community.





2. ENVIRONMENT DAY CELEBRATION:

The Environment Day celebration at our school is an annual event that underscores our commitment to environmental conservation and sustainability.
